County Engineer present. Time for the continuation of the public hearing for Drainage District No. 28 engineer's report. County Engineer indicated that he was unable to speak with the landowner requesting the repairs as that landowner was in China for 10 days. Moved by Leupold, seconded by Allen to continue the public hearing on Drainage District No. 28 engineer's report to April 3, 2012, at 9:45 A.M. All voted aye.

Moved by Allen, seconded by Leupold to approve four (4) underground, three phase, 12470 volt power line crossings, cased in continuous PVC conduit, the purpose of which is upgrading the line to three phase for 2 services. The locations are:

Under 220th Street on the east side of 230th Avenue

Under 225th Street at 2200 225th St. on west side of drive

Under 225th Street at 2305 225th St. on east of side of drive

Under 225th Street approximately 275 feet east of 2305 225th Street

All voted aye.

Moved by Johnson, seconded by Jordan to approve an overhead line and underground crossing. The line will be a single phase, 7200 volt power line on 200th Street, and the purpose of which is replacing the existing power line and getting it out of the trees. The line will begin approximately 3800 feet east of the intersection with 190th Avenue, then easterly 1050 feet, then boring under 200th street all within sections 27 and 34 Lakeville Township. All voted aye.

Moved by Johnson, seconded by Jordan to approve Joint DD #2 D&O repair work for Walt Norem in Section 31 of Excelsior Township, the estimated cost of the repair to be \$500. All voted aye.

Moved by Allen, seconded by Leupold to approve DD #25 repair work for Dave Gottsche in Section 9, Milford Township, and the costs estimated to be less than \$1000. Gottsche abstained from voting and the rest of the board was aye.

Mary Jensen, Trails Board, present with a request for a resolution to accept and expend Transportation Enhancement funds. Assistant County Attorney will prepare a resolution for the board consideration next week.

The Board considered the purchase of wetland lots previously discussed during the East Okoboji Beach Urban Renewal project and their impact on the Low Impact Development portion of the project. Supervisor Allen has negotiated a price that is acceptable with the property owner and would like to see the county purchase. Moved by Jordan, Seconded by Allen to approve the purchase of four lots in East Okoboji Beach, currently owned by Wade and Debbie Salzwedel at a price of \$17,000 described at Lots 1, 25, and 26 Block 3 Unit 1 and Lot 3, Block 6, Unit 1, Plat of East Okoboji Beach. Roll call vote: Allenaye, Jordan-aye, Leupold-aye, Gottsche-nay, and Johnson-abstained. Motion carried.

There being no further items for business presented before the Board, it was moved by Leupold seconded by Jordan to adjourn. All voted aye.
