## Dickinson County Board of Supervisors November 12, 2013

10:30 A.M. Present are Supervisors Paul Johnson, Mardi Allen, Pam Jordan, Bill Leupold, Vice-Chairperson and Chairperson David Gottsche.

Pledge of allegiance to the flag was recited by those present.

Ann Ditsworth, County Recorder, present with a report on the activity of the Dickinson County Endowment Fund for the past year including the group's accomplishments and the grants funds disbursed to the 2013 grant recipients.

County Recorder presented a request to an amendment to the recorder department budget for the fiscal year 2014. The amendment is requested due to the software conversion project and delays with the scheduling resulting in the expenditures being paid in two different fiscal years. The request is for an increase to current year budget in the amount of \$15,000. Moved by Allen, seconded by Leupold to propose a budget amendment in the amount of \$15,000 in the Government Services to Residents fiscal year 2014 and to set a public hearing on said amendment for December 3, 2013 beginning at 9:30 a.m. and to instruct the county auditor to prepare and cause to be published said proposed amendment. Roll call vote: Johnson-aye, Allen-aye, Jordan-aye, Leupold-aye, and Gottsche-aye.

Jean Martin, Trails Board, present with a change order needing authorization. Following explanation of the need for the change order, it was moved by Jordan, seconded by Allen to approve Change Order No. 1 for the 2013 Hwy 86 Trail Improvements, Div. I & III, in the amount on Division III of \$11,793.69. Roll call vote: Johnson-aye, Allen-aye, Jordan-aye, Leupold-aye and Gottsche-aye.

Next Jean presented the Trails Board annual report and upcoming issues concerning maintenance of the trails. Trails Vice-Chair Barry Sackett present information to the Supervisors on setting up two Okoboji Foundation Funds. One fund would be The Endow lowa Fund that will be used to set up a long term Maintenance Endowment and The Campaign Fund that will be used to hold donations received for Trails Projects. Two agreements were presented for the board's approval. It was decided to put this in the next week's agenda so the board would have time to review and two agreements.

Kirby Range and Theresa Beck as the Supervisors representatives to the Dickinson County Compensation Board to a four year term each retroactively beginning July 1, 2013.
