

How to Sell Your Vehicle in Iowa Checklist

Buyer's Acknowledgement Form

Seller's Checklist (some counties may require more information)

- Remove License Plates
- Odometer Statement completed and given to buyer
- Damage Disclosure Statement completed and given to buyer
- **Title** Assigned to buyer. Give the buyer the name of the county where your car was last registered and the date your license plates expire.
- Bill of Sale filled out by both seller and buyer
- If Vehicle Sold to Out of State Buyer properly assigned certificate of title is delivered to buyer. Registration receipt turned into your county treasurer
- Vehicle Sold for Junk Give buyer certificate of title. Get receipt stating buyer has accepted delivery of car and title (see below)
- Refund Make claim for refund of unused registration fees, if:
 - 1. The excess credit for your sold, junked or traded vehicle is \$10 or more.
 - 2. Vehicle is sold or junked and credit is not claimed for a replacement vehicle and the refund is \$10 or greater.
