VOTING PRECINCTS and POLLING PLACES

Precinct No. 1—Silver Lake-Excelsior (District 4)

City of Lake Park, all of rural Silver Lake Township and Excelsior Township.
Lake Park Community Center, 903 S. Market Street, Lake Park.

Precinct No. 2—Diamond Lake-Lakeville Rural (District 4)

All of Diamond Lake Township and rural Lakeville Township.

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Dickinson County Expo Building, 1600 15th St., Spirit Lake.

Precinct No. 3—Spirit Lake-Orleans (District 1)

City of Orleans, all of rural Spirit Lake Township and that part of rural Center Grove Township lying northwest of Spirit Lake North Precinct (see census block map for detail).

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Dickinson County Expo Building, 1600 15th St., Spirit Lake.

Precinct No. 4—Richland-Superior (District 2)

City of Superior, all of rural Richland Township and all of rural Superior Township.

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Dickinson County Expo Building, 1600 15th St., Spirit Lake.

Precinct No. 5—Center Grove South-Arnolds Park (District 2)

City of Arnolds Park, and all of rural Center Grove Township easterly of the chain of Lakes and not described in Precincts 8, 11 and 12.

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Hedberg Theater, 243 Broadway St, Arnolds Park, IA 51331

Combined Precinct No. 6—Lloyd-Terril and Precinct No. 7—Milford Rural

City of Terril and all of rural Lloyd Township and Milford Township rural except Sections 4, 5, 6, part of N ½ of 7, N ½ 8, all of 9 and N ½ of 16

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Terril Memorial Building, 115 N. State Street, Terril.

Precinct No. 8—Okoboji-Milford (District 3)

City of Milford, and Okoboji Township rural East of 180th Avenue except part of Section 4 but including part Section 5, and Milford Township rural Sections 4, 5, 6, part of N½ of 7, N½ of 8, all of 9 and N½ of 16, (see census block maps for detail), and two Center Grove Township Census Blocks. **Milford Community Building East Room, 806 N Avenue, Milford.**

Precinct No. 9—Westport (District 4)

All of Westport Township and rural Okoboji Township West of 180th Avenue except part of Section 5, but including part Section 4, (see census block maps for detail).

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Milford Community Building East Room, 806 N Avenue, Milford.

Precinct No. 10—Wahpeton-West Okoboji (District 2)

City of Wahpeton and City of West Okoboji.

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Milford Community Building East Room, 806 N Avenue, Milford.

Precinct No. 11—Center Grove West-Okoboji (District 4)

City of Okoboji and rural Center Grove Township west of Highway 71.

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Hedberg Theater, 243 Broadway St, Arnolds Park, IA 51331

Precinct No. 12—Center Grove East Rural (District 5)

Rural Center Grove Township lying south and southeast of Spirit Lake City and west of County Road M56 in parts Sections 2,3,8,9,10,11,14,15,16,17, and 20 (includes the subdivisions of Francis Sites, Loch Knolls, East Okoboji Beach, Arthur Heights and East Oak Estates).

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Dickinson County Expo Building, 1600 15th St., Spirit Lake.

Precinct No. 13—Spirit Lake North (District 1)

Spirit Lake North as defined by city ordinance, being all that part of the City that lies east of the IA Highway 9 bridge commencing at the west shore of East Okoboji Lake, including the territory that comprises East Okoboji Lake north of the IA Highway 9 bridge, and the area North of a line commencing at the IA Highway 9 bridge then west on IA Highway 9 to the intersection of 155th Street, then West on 155th Street to 219th Avenue, then North on 219th Avenue to IA Highway 9, also including that part of the city west of 219th Avenue, and part of unincorporated Center Grove Township (see census block maps for detail).

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Dickinson County Expo Building, 1600 15th St., Spirit Lake.

Precinct No. 14—Spirit Lake West (District 1)

Spirit Lake West as defined by city ordinance, being all that part of the City not included in the North Precinct that lies south of IA Highway 9 and west of a line commencing at the intersection of IA Highway 9 and Peoria Avenue south to 23rd Street, then west on 23rd Street to Sunner Avenue, then south on Sunner Avenue to the southern City limits, and part of unincorporated Center Grove Township (see census block maps for detail).

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Dickinson County Expo Building, 1600 15th St., Spirit Lake.

Precinct No. 15—Spirit Lake South (District 5)

Spirit Lake South as defined by city ordinance, being all that part of the City not included in the North Precinct and the West Precinct as described herein, and part of unincorporated Center Grove Township (See census block maps for detail).

NOTE CHANGE IN LOCATION: Dickinson County Expo Building, 1600 15th St., Spirit Lake.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered, such as voters registering to vote on Election Day-and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required. 1) may have voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by November 8, 2021 at 12:00 p.m. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
