

**Dickinson County Board of Supervisors  
April 19, 2022**

9:00 A.M. Present are Supervisors Kim Wermersen, Steve Clark, Jeff Thee, Tim Fairchild Vice-Chairperson and Chairperson Bill Leupold.

The pledge of allegiance to the flag was recited by those present.

Steve Anderson, Iowa Great Lakes Sanitary District, present to discuss the purchase of real estate that is currently owned by Dickinson County. Greg Baloun, Dickinson County Sheriff, also present, and informed the board of wanting the real estate as well. After further discussion, the contract died after lack of a motion. The board encouraged them to reevaluate and come back with a different offer if they choose to.

Moved by Clark, seconded by Wermersen, to approve the April 12, 2022 Board Meeting Minutes. Roll call vote: Clark-aye, Wermersen-aye, Thee-aye, Fairchild-aye, and Leupold-aye.

Moved by Thee, seconded by Fairchild, to approve drainage claim for DD48 to Hudson Law Firm in the amount of \$70. Roll call vote: Thee-aye, Fairchild-aye, Wermersen-aye, Clark-aye, and Leupold-aye.

Moved by Clark, seconded by Wermersen, to make a recommendation to approve DD1 repair work for Clinton Pavelko in Section #6 of Lloyd Township. The repair should be less than \$500. Roll call vote: Clark-aye, Wermersen-aye, Thee-aye, Fairchild-aye, and Leupold-aye.

Moved by Clark, seconded by Thee, to make a recommendation to approve DD1 repair work for Clinton Pavelko in Section #5 of Lloyd Township. The repair should be less than \$1,000

Moved by Fairchild, seconded by Wermersen, to make a recommendation to approve DD50 Beaver Dam removal for Kent Eilers in Section #6 of Milford Township. The repair should be less than \$1,000. Roll call vote: Fairchild-aye, Wermersen-aye, Clark-aye, Thee-aye, and Leupold-aye.

Dan Eckert, Dickinson County Engineer, explained to the board the issues in DD51 Outlet. Part of this issue is also involved in Jackson County, Minnesota. After further discussion, Eckert will get estimates and talk with landowners.

The Board gave their board and committee reports and continued into general discussion. There being no further items presented to the board, moved by Thee, seconded by Clark, to adjourn. All voted aye. Meeting adjourned to the call of the Chairperson at 10:03 a.m.
