

Dickinson County Board of Supervisors
August 9, 2022

9:00 A.M. Present are Supervisors Kim Wermersen, Steve Clark, Jeff Thee, Tim Fairchild Vice-Chairperson, and Chairperson Bill Leupold.

The pledge of allegiance to the flag was recited by those present.

Time for the 9:00 a.m. Continued Completion Hearing for DD48. Rick Hopper, Jacobson Westergard engineer, present to explain to the board the reasoning for the continuation. Thane Johnson, landowner, present to explain to the board the claim he submitted for reimbursement of damage on his property. Johnson showed video footage of damage and part of his property that was not left as it was before the project started. The board and Steve Goodlow, Assistant County Attorney, examined the code for drainage to which states that there needs to be proof on negligence in order to pursue any damage claims. The completion hearing was closed by Leupold. After further discussion and failed motions, it was moved by Wermersen, seconded by Thee, to approve the completion hearing and approve a claim to Johnson in the amount of \$4,000 that will go against the contractor's retainage. Moved by Thee, seconded by Wermersen, to approve the drainage claim for Goodwin Law Office for DD48 in the amount of \$50. Roll call vote: Thee-aye, Wermersen-aye, Clark-aye, Fairchild-aye, and Leupold-aye.

Moved by Thee, seconded by Clark, to approve the drainage claim for Jacobson Westergard for DD48 in the amount of \$2,700. Roll call vote: Thee-aye, Clark-aye, Wermersen-aye, Fairchild-aye, and Leupold-aye.

Moved by Fairchild, seconded by Clark, to approve the claims as listed on the August 9, 2022, Claims Register Listing. Roll call vote: Fairchild-aye, Clark-aye, Wermersen-aye, Thee-aye, and Leupold-aye.
